AN ACT to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ending on the 3st day of March, 2002 and to appropriate the sums granted in this Session of Parliament.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2001. Short title.

2. The Accountant-General may, on the warrant of the Minister, issue out of the Consolidated Fund, a sum not exceeding in aggregate, Sixty-seven Thousand, Four Hundred and Ninety-seven Million and Ninety-five Thousand Dollars

and Ninety-seven Million and Ninety-five Thousand Dollars for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government of Jamaica, and for other purposes, for the financial year ending on the 31st day of March, 2002.

3.—(1) The sum granted by section 2 is hereby appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule, pursuant to and in accordance with, subsection (1) of section 116 of the Constitution of Jamaica, and shall be
